Sudden death in South Washington -- Col. C.A. Alexander, an old citizen of the Seventh Ward, died at his residence at the corner of D and 11th streets, Island, quite suddenly yesterday of apoplexy. He was well in the morning, and attended to his business as usual. The deceased was 69 years of age, and a native of Alexandria, Va., but had lived here for many years.
