Death Call Sudden

George Allen, Veteran Market Man, Succumbs to Attack of Vertigo

George Allen, seventy-three years old, who had been in the produce business in the Eastern market for the last twenty-five years, died suddenly this morning at his home, 226 7th street southeast. When he became ill Dr. F.F. Repetti, 449 B street southeast, was summoned, but death occurred before the physician reached the house.

Mr. Allen, who had not been in good health during the past two years, suffered an attack of vertigo last Saturday. He was able to attend church Sunday, but since that time he has had to remain indoors.

Mr. Allen formerly lived at Oxon Hill, Prince George county, Md., where he was prominently identified with the Methodist Church, being a member of the church board. Arrangements for the funeral have not yet been completed.
