Coroner Probes Death Of Man Thought Drunk

Coroner A. Magruder MacDonald today was investigating the death of Bernard I. Anderson, 41, of 1003 Eleventh street S.E., who died in Casualty Hospital this morning, possibly from a brain concussion.

Police said the man was found unconscious shortly before last midnight in a vacant lot in the 1200 block of Good Hope road S.E., and was taken to Gallinger Hospital, where a Gallinger physician examined him and described him as drunk.

The man then was taken to the eleventh precinct police station. Later in the night, policemen on duty at the station decided the man was sick and ordered him removed to Casualty Hospital for examination.

At Casualty Hospital he was admitted for observation of a possible concussion. He died a short time later.
