The Funeral of Col. Ephraim F. Anderson, a former member of the Maryland legislature, and for ten years an appraiser in the Baltimore custom house, who died at Providence Hospital, Thursday afternoon, aged about thirty-eight years of consumption, took place in this city this morning. He recruited a company in the Seventh Maryland regiment, served in the war as its captain, and was wounded at the battle of the Wilderness and taken prisoner. He held the rank of colonel by brevet. Col. Anderson recently returned from Florida, where he went for his health. He was unmarried.
