An Old Soldier Mustered Out

William A. Andre of 317 9th street southeast died yesterday. He was a veteran of the late war, having served for three years in the thirteenth and sixth New York heavy artillery, and subsequently as first sergeant in the United States army. He was a member of Kit Carson Post, No. 2, G.A.R., of which he was at one time adjutant, and has been a faithful clerk in the War Department for the past 26 years. He leaves a wife and eight children, and a large circle of friends, who held him in the highest esteem. The funeral will take place tomorrow afternoon at 3 o'clock, under the auspices of Kit Carson Post, No. 2, and the interment will be at Congressional Cemetery.
