On Wednesday, Cornelius Arlen, the driver of a wood cart, in the employ of Mr. A. Woodward, Capitol Hill, was thrown from the cart while passing through the Seventh ward, receiving such severe injuries that he died in a few hours. The deceased was a German, aged about 46 years. The police of the Seventh ward and Mr. Woodward did all in their power to relieve the sufferings of the poor man.
