Funeral of Joseph H. Aukward

Was for Thirty Years Employed at Hospital for the Insane

Joseph H. Aukward, who died Monday evening at his residence, No. 128 D street southeast, aged sixty-two years, had been an employee of the Government Hospital for the Insane for thirty years past. He was connected with the construction force in the capacity of foreman and had been engaged in many of the building projects at the institution for some years. He was the contractor for the main dining hall built adjacent to the detached buildings, which he erected during a suspension of the regular work of the hospital. He was at one time employed at the Bloomingdale Hospital, in New York.

His funeral, which was largely attended, was held this morning from St. Peter's Church on Capitol Hill, where requiem high mass was offered at 9:30 o'clock. The interment was made in a local cemetery. Mr. Aukward had been absent from his duties at the hospital for a number of weeks, but his demise was a cause of surprise and regret to his associates and friends.
