"The body of a drowned man was found on the shore of the Potomac river near Fort Washington, on Tuesday last, and a jury of inquest held over it. The jury rendered a verdict of accidental drowning. There was found in the pockets on the deceased the sum of sixteen dollars and one cent, and a paper indicating his name to be Joseph Bailey.
