Mrs. Inez D. Balderston Dead

Illness Which Began Last Evening Terminated Fatally

Mrs. Inez Dimitry Balderston, wife of Walter C. Balderston, died this morning about 9 o'clock, Mrs. Balderston was apparently in the best of health until about 10 o'clock last evening, when she became seriously ill and grew steadily worse until her death.

Mrs. Balderston was born May 7, 1872, and was for many years a teacher in the Washington public schools. She was the daughter of Mary A. and the late William H. Daniel of this city, the latter being for many years identified with church and musical circles, a prominent member of the Choral Society and precentor of the choir of St. John's Episcopal Church.

Mrs. Balderston's husband, mother and two brothers Ernest H. Daniel and L. Percy Daniel survive.
