Death of William H. Baldwin

Mr. William H. Baldwin died this morning at his residence, in LeDroit Park, after a long illness. The immediate cause of death was dropsy of the heart, Mr. Baldwin was a builder, and as a member of the firm of Baldwin Bros. he erected a large number of the prominent buildings in this city. In recent years he constructed the Hooe building, on F street, now occupied by the Geological Survey, and the Adams' building, on the opposite side of the street. He was a member of Trinity (P.E.) church. He leaves a wife and a son, Mr. Ralph Baldwin. His wife was a sister of the late Mr. Z.D. Gilman, the well-known druggist.
