Four generations of descendants - about 70 relatives in all - attended funeral services yesterday for Mrs. Ella F. Ballenger at St. Peter's Catholic Church, 313 2nd St. SE.

Mrs. Ballenger, 95, a resident of Washington since 1886, died Friday at Carroll Manor Nursing Home after a long illness.

Mrs. Ballenger, the former Ella F. Hayden, was a native of Charles County, Md. She came to the District 80 years ago at the age of 16 to marry the late James A. Ballenger, then an employe of the Navy Department at the old Navy Yard. He died in 1927.

She operated a boarding house at 218 2nd St. SE from 1924 to 1959.

She leaves two daughters, Mrs. Joseph A. Heberie, of 1838 S St. SE, and Mrs. Charles A. Everett of Mathalie, Va.; a son, John F., of Orlando, Fla., 14 grandchildren, 46 great-grandchildren and 11 great-great-grandchildren.
