Two Boys Drowned

About ten o'clock this morning two boys were upset in a skiff in the Eastern branch, in front of Guinand's wharf (foot of 3d street s.e.), by running foul of a schooner, and both of them were drowned. The body of one of them--Joseph Dailey, 16 years old, living at 1211 3d street--was recovered and taken to his home, and the body of the other, whose name is unknown, had not been recovered at one o'clock.
