Three Victims Die In Auto Mishaps Score Injured—D.C. Woman Killed and Nine Hurt in Five-Car Crash

Two persons were killed and nearly a score injured as slippery roads led to many automobile accidents on nearby Maryland and Virginia roads over the weekend.

A third fatality resulted when a woman, injured on the Lee Highway Friday, died at Emergency Hospital.

The dead are Mrs. Suzelle Carroll, first block of V street; Corpl. Mack Marosy, 1300 block of Eleventh street, and Mrs. Anice L. Bayne, 1300 block of Maplewood street.
