Death of Mr. Blanchard

Mrs. James M. Blanchard died at his home in this city last evening after an illness of about two years. The deceased was for a long period a builder of locomotives and afterward a railway superintendent. Coming to this city at the opening of the war, he served as examiner in the Patent office for several years and was afterward well known as a patent attorney in this city and New York.
