The Funeral of Mr. John Bohlayer, yesterday afternoon, was attended by the Grand Lodge and Harmony Lodge, No. 9, I.O.O.F., with Prosperi's band of music, and two tribes of Red Men, with martial music. After religious exercises at the house of the deceased by the Rev. Messrs. Dumm and Effinger, the corpse was conveyed to the Congressional Cemetery, where the ceremonies of the Odd Fellows and Red Men were performed, and the body interred.
