William T. Bright, 93, Native of City, Dies

Former Government Worker to Be Buried Monday in Congressional Cemetery

William T. Bright, 93, a resident of Washington all his life, died suddenly this morning at his home, 235 Eighth street southeast. He had been prominent in the affairs of the southeast section for three-quarters of a century.

Mr. Bright was in the Government service and served in the Coast and Geodetic Survey for many years prior to his retirement about 25 years ago. He was a member of Ingram Memorial Congregational Church.

He is survived by two sons, Cyrus T. and Ross M. Bright; two daughters, Misses Emma and Clara L. Bright, and two grandchildren, B. Brooke and Esther Louise Bright, all of this city.
