The Funeral of David Broughton

The funeral of the late David Broughton, who died on Sunday morning of paralysis, took place this afternoon from Wesley M.E. Chapel, and was attended by a large number of friends. Mr. Broughton was the father-in-law of Messrs. J.W. Scott and B.W. Gheen, of this city, and had lived here for many years. He was a native of Washington county, N.Y. For some years he had a farm in Virginia and a livery stable in Alexandria. He was for a time (with his son-in-law, Mr. Scott,) lessee of the American house and the proprietor of a stable on 14th and D streets. He was a consistent member of the Methodist church.
