Mrs. Brown, 85, Widow of Hearst Political Writer

Mrs. George Rothwell Brown, widow of a political reporter for the Hearst newspapers, died after a heart attack yesterday at White Stone, Va. She as 85.

The former Zenaydee Hutton, Mrs. Brown was born in Goldsboro, N.C., and came to Washington about 1897. Five years later she was married to Mr. Brown, then a reporter for the Washington Times.

Mr. Brown, who later worked for the Washington Post before joining the Hearst organization in 1929, died while covering the 1960 Republican National Convention.

For nearly a year Mrs. Brown had lived at White Stone with her son, Brig. Gen. Rothwell H. Brown, USA (ret.). Besides Gen. Brown, she leaves a daughter, Mrs. George Bell, 44447 Hawthorne street N.W., six grandchildren, and eight great-grandchildren.

Services will be at 11 a.m. tomorrow at Grace Episcopal Church in Kilmarnock, Va. Burial will be private.
