### **Died As Father Died**

#### **Painter Burgess Falls While Painting House Exterior**

Percy Burgess, thirty-one years old, who while painting at 1409 Delafield place yesterday, fell and sustained an injury to his head and internal injuries, died at Garfield Hospital about 10 o'clock last night.

Abner Burgess, his father, also a painter, met death in a similar manner while working at Congress Heights about three years ago.

The young man was painting over a window yesterday, standing on a temporary scaffold, and was precipitated to a porch on the ground floor. His head struck the porch and rendered him unconscious. Today his body was removed to his late home, 425 13th street southwest. He is survived by his wife and three children.
