J. Eldridge Burns Dies

Deceased Was Market Master at Western Market

J. Eldridge Burns, prominent Mason, market master at the Western market and a lifelong resident of Washington, died at Johns Hopkins Hospital, Baltimore, Md., Wednesday.

Funeral services will be conducted at the residence of his nephew, Harry Roache, 1238 Columbia road, tomorrow at 2 o'clock. Interment will be in the Congressional cemetery.

Mr. Burns was a member of Myron M. Parker Lodge, No. 37, F.A.A.M.; Capitol Chapter, No. 11, Royal Arch Masons; Columbia commandery of Knights Templar, and was associated with Bethlehem Chapter, No. 7, of the Order of the Eastern Star. He was a member of the Methodist Church.
