Woman Inhales Gas To End Long Illness

Leaving a note begging forgiveness for her act and explaining she felt she would never recover from an illness with which she has been suffering for the past three years, Mrs. Mary Alice Carroll, 60 years old, of 1468 Girard street, ended her life yesterday afternoon by inhaling illuminating gas.

A sister, Mrs. Georgia W. Thomas, had neighbors summon the fire rescue squad and Casualty Hospital ambulance when she discovered the body in the kitchen upon returning home from a shopping trip, but the woman was pronounced dead on the arrival of those units. Coroner J. Ramsay Nevitt issued a suicide certificate.

Mrs. Carroll, a widow, is survived by her sister and a daughter, Miss Helen Carroll, an employe at the Patent Officer.
