#### **Surviving Son Won French Cross and Citation**

Funeral services for Mrs. Rosa Ella Chaney, wife of Andrew W. Chaney, who died Monday morning, were held at the home of her daughter, Mrs. D.H. Roland Drury, 1653 Hobart street at 2 o'clock this afternoon. Interment was private.

Mrs. Chaney was sixty-two years old, and her death followed a long illness. She had lived in Washington forty-five years, coming here from Baltimore county, Md. Besides her husband she is survived by a son, J. Harry Chaney, who recently returned from overseas, where he was a sergeant in the American forces. He received the croix de guerre and a citation from Gen. Pershing. Five daughters also survive Mrs. Chaney--Mrs. D. Roland Drury, Mrs. H.A. Matthews, Mrs. James N. Bobbit, Mrs. Claude M. Estes and Mrs. James D. Hobbs.
