Dr. Elmon A. Cook, Former Official in Revenue Bureau, Dies



Dr. Elmon A. Cook, 79, a native of Washington and a member of an old Washington family, died here yesterday after a long illness. He lived at the Kenesaw Apartments, Sixteenth and Irving streets N.W.

He was the son of the late George R. Cook, a resident of Capitol Hill for many years.

Dr. Cook was graduated in 1898 from the old Columbian College medical school, now George Washington University Medical School. He practiced medicine here for a short time, then entered private business here.

Dr. Cook worked for the Bureau of Internal Revenue for 24 years. He retired in 1942 as head of the Personal Audit Section, Income Tax Unit.

After his retirement from the bureau, Dr. Cook served with the rtion board in his area during World War II and later was associated for six years with S. Kann Sons, department store.

One of the oldest summer residents of Washington Grove, Md., Dr. Cook once served as president of the old Washington Grove Association, a Methodist camp meeting organization. During his term of office, Washington Grove was reorganized as a town under a State charter.

Dr. Cook was a member of Naval Masonic Lodge No. 4 here.

His daughter, Mis Dorothea A. Cook, is principal of Buchanan School here.

Besides his daughter, he is survived by his widow, Mrs. Bessie B. Cook.
