### **Death Due To Accident**

### **Verdict in Case of Man Who Died From Fall**

A certificate of accidental death was issued late yesterday by Coroner J. Ramsay Nevitt in the case of Austin R. Cooper, 25 years old, of 816 Twenty-first street, who died at the Emergency Hospital from injuries received when he fell from the running board of a Washington Post delivery truck Saturday morning.

Cooper, a “jumper” on the truck, was taken to Sibley Hospital with a fractured skull and severe lacerations of the face and head after the accident.
