Mrs. Mary A. Daniel Dies In Home of Son

Widow of St. John's Church Musical Director Will Be Buried Tomorrow

Mrs. Mary A. Daniel widow of William H. Daniel died at 11 o'clock yesterday morning at the residence of her son, Ernest H. Daniel, president of the Carry Ice Cream Co., 2111 Nineteenth Street. Funeral services will be held at the residence tomorrow afternoon at 2 o'clock. Interment will be in Congressional Cemetery.

Mrs. Daniel's husband who died in 1897, was director of music at St. John's Episcopal Church, Sixteenth and I streets, 16 years. He was a son of the late Prof Joseph Humphrey Daniel, prominent for many years as head of the music department of the public schools of the District of Columbia and well-remembered by the older residents of this city.

Mrs. Daniel was a daughter of Dr. William Brown, a veteran of the Mexican War, and at one time in command at the hospital at the marine barracks here. In addition to her son, Ernest H. Daniel, with whom she made her home of late years, one other son, Maj. Leonard P. Daniel of the United States Geological Survey, who resides at Falls Church, Va. survives her.

Interment will be in the family plot which descended to Mrs. Daniel as one of the Young heirs, the Young family having been the original owners of the property, a part of which is now Congressional Cemetery. Title has been in the family since 1818.
