Burial Rites Are Held for Mrs. Davy

Funeral services for Mrs. Walter B. Davy, 55, a District school teacher for 33 years, were held yesterday at her home at 5603 Potomac ave. nw. Burial was in Congressional Cemetery.

A Washington native, Mrs. Davy died of a heart attack at her home Saturday.

The former Miss Marion L. Ferris, Mrs. Davy was educated at Eastern High School and Wilson Teachers College. She taught for 20 years at the Francis Scott Key School, and was also assigned at various times to the Edmonds, Brent, Reservoir and Addison schools.

Her last assignment, begun in September, 1948, was at the Hyde School, 32d and O sts. nw. She handled Junior Red Cross activities at Hyde and was in charge of the school's Christmas play. She had also directed plays during her years at the Key School.

She was a member of the National Education Association, the District Education Association and the Potomac Heights Community Church.

Surviving are her husband, a salesman for the Electrolux Corp.; two sons, William Allen Davy, Montpelier, Vt., and John Robert Davy of the home address; a sister, Miss Lillian M. Ferris, and two brothers, Lester S. Ferris and Robert A. Ferris, all of Washington.
