David H. Deibler, 68, who designed and built custom homes in the Washington area and Rehobeth Beach, Del., died of cancer Jan. 20 at Lancaster Community Hospital in Pennsylvania.

From the early 1970s to the early 1990s, Mr. Deibler owned and operated Dinner Bell Inn in Rehoboth and the Rehoboth Bay Marina in Dewey Beach, Del.
