Serious Accident

Edward P. Dunham, a printer, met with a sad accident on Tuesday last, while bathing at Galt's wharf. On jumping into the water it is supposed he struck a broken pile, breaking his spinal cord and some of his ribs. He was taken from the water completely paralyzed, and conveyed to his home on D street between 9th and 10th, where he lies in a very critical condition.

Died of His Injuries

Edward P. Dunham, a well known printer of this city, died about 5 o'clock this morning, at his residence, on D street, between 9th and 10th, from the affects of an accident on the 21st of June, at Galt's wharf, by injuring his spinal cord and breaking some of his ribs, in striking a hidden pile, while diving in the water at that place. When taken from the water he was completely paralyzed, in which condition he has remained ever since. He was a single man, and lived with his parents.
