Retired U.S. Employe

James Aloysius Dorsey, 74, retired statistical clerk of the Commerce Department, died yesterday in Prince Georges Hospital after a four-month illness. Mr. Dorsey, who lived at 5006 Forty-seventh avenue, Edmonston, Md., had been a patient in the hospital about 10 days.

A resident of the Washington area since 1894, Mr. Dorsey began Government service as a customs clerk in New Orleans at the age of 19. He was transferred here to work in the Treasury Department.

Mr. Dorsey, who had lived in Edmonston for 20 years, was handling export and import statistics for the Commerce Department at the time of his retirement in 1933.

Surviving are his widow, Mrs. Georgia Dorsey, and a brother, Edward J. Dorsey of New York. Requiem mass will be said at 10 a.m., Monday at St. Jerome's Church, Hyattsville. Burial will be in Congressional Cemetery.
