Child Drowned

On Saturday afternoon as a daughter of Mr. R. Dougherty, was playing in company with a colored girl near the brick kiln of Mr. John Grinder, near the Brick Bridge on New Jersey Avenue, both of them fell into a pond. Mrs. Dougherty got the colored girl out and by great exertions restored her life not knowing until too late, that her own child had been drowned at the same time.
