Former Patient At St Elizabeths Ends His Life

Apparently despondent because of ill health, Richard Daugherty, 41, a paroled patient from St. Elizabeths Hospital, shot and killed himself at his home 2316 Nicholson Street Southeast yesterday.

He fired a bullet from a .22-caliber rifle into his left temple about 8:30 a.m., police said. His mother, Mrs. Effie Kenner, found him lying on the floor of a basement garage. He was dead when a doctor arrived from Casualty Hospital.

Detectives were told that the man had threatened to kill himself several times since being paroled from St. Elizabeths two years ago. A certificate of suicide was issued by Coroner A. Magruder MacDonald.
