Dr. James F. Douglas, 81, Retired Physician Dies

Dr. James Franklin Douglas, 81 retired Washington physician, died yesterday at Emergency Hospital after a short illness. He lived at 1209 Floral street N.W.

A native of Washington, Dr. Douglas was the son of the late James C. and Mary Franklin Douglas. He was educated in the public schools of the District and in 1892 was graduated from the Columbian Medical College, now a part of George Washington University. He practiced in Washington until retiring several years ago.

Dr. Douglas was a life member of the District Medical Society, a member of the Sons of the American Revolution and the Masonic Veterans' Association and the St. Alban's Episcopal Church.

Surviving are a son James F. Douglas, jr. a daughter, Mrs. Ralph F. Thompson, both of Washington and three grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held at 10:30 a.m. Friday at the home with Dr. Charles T. Warner, rector of St. Alban's Church officiating. Burial will be private.
