Lifelong Resident of City to Be Buried in Congressional Cemetery

Mrs. Laura A. Dudley, 51 years old, died yesterday in her home, 901 Fifth street northeast, of pleurisy and pneumonia. Funeral services probably will be held tomorrow at 2 o'clock in the chapel, Congressional cemetery, by the Rev. A.E. Spielman, with interment in Congressional cemetery.

Mrs. Dudley was born in Prince Georges county, Md., and had been almost a lifelong resident of Washington. She was a war mother. She was active in Temple chapter of the Eastern Star order and was a member of the Patriotic Order of America and of the Daughters of America. Her husband, Joseph E. Dudley; a son, Frank E. Dudley; two brothers, John and Frederick Shepherd; two sisters, Mrs. Margaret Moran and Mrs. Annie Langley, and two grandchildren, all of this city, survive her.
