A memorial service in celebration of the life of James R. Mr. Duell died in Washington, D.C., on Wednesday, July 15, 1992. He later completed two years of graduate work at Mississippi State University, after which he returned to Washington, D.C. in 1971 to accept a position with the Immigration and Naturalization Service.
