H.R. Duffey, 49, Ex-FBI Agent

Horace R. Duffey, 49, a Washington native and former FBI agent, died Wednesday in Toms River, N.J., after a long illness.

Mr. Duffey retired and moved to Toms River this fall after 23 years of service with the FBI. He had been agent in charge at Phoenix, Ariz.; San Diego, Calif; Savannah Ga., and Denver, Colo.

He was the son of the late Dr. Hugh Clarence Duffey, a Washington physician. Two brothers, Hugh C., jr, and Depue H., both deceased, also were physicians here.

Survivors include his widow, the former Winifred Prior, of Toms River, and two sisters, Mrs. Shannon D. Carmer of 2627 Adams Mill road N.W. and Miss Margaret Duffey of 3911 Morrison street N.W.

Horace R. Duffey, 49, a native of Washington who spent 23 years as an agent for the Federal Bureau of Investigation, died Wednesday night at his home in Toms River, N.J., after a long illness.

Mr. Duffey attended Central High School here and was a pitcher on Central's baseball team. From there he went on to Duke University where he was also a member of the baseball team. He was graduated from the National University law school in 1930 and joined the FBI in 1932.

Mr. Duffey made his home in Toms River after retiring from the FBI because of illness. During his career he was agent-in-charge of branches at Phoenix, Ariz., San Diego, Calif., Denver, Colo., and Savannah, Ga.

He leaves his wife, Winifred Prior Duffey, of Toms River, and two sisters, Ms. Shannon D. Cramer, 2627 Adams Mill rd. nw., and Margaret Duffey, 3911 Morrison st. nw.

Mr. Duffey was the son of the late Dr. H. Clarence Duffey and the brother of the late Drs. Hugh C. Duffey and DePue H. Duffey.

Graveside services will be held at 2 p.m. Saturday in Congressional Cemetery.
