Death of Mr. A.A. Duly

The staff of the United States national museum has sustained a serious loss in the death of Mr. A.A. Duly, chief engineer from the foundation of the establishment. Mr. Duly was greatly respected by all his associates in the museum and it will be difficult to fill the vacancy occasioned by his death.
