Mrs. Duncanson Dies

Widow of Masonic Official Victim of Paralysis

Mrs. Eliza H. Duncanson, 75 years old, widow of Charles C. Duncanson and a resident of this city for the last 50 years died at the Eastern Star Home Monday. Mr. Duncanson was for many years treasurer of the Grand Lodge of Masons in this city and was prominent in banking and other business circles here.

Mrs. Duncanson's death was due to a stroke of paralysis which she suffered about three weeks ago. She had, however been in bad health for a year and a half.

Mrs. Duncanson had been in the Eastern Star Home for about three years. She is survived by a brother, Thomas J. Young of this city.

Funeral services will be conducted at Hines funeral parlors, 2901 Fourteenth street, this afternoon at 3 o'clock. Interment will be in Congressional Cemetery.
