Mrs. Helen M. Dunn Dies; Native of Washington

Mrs. Helen Margaret Dunn, 79, native of Washington and sister of the late Capt. Walter Martin McFarland, once acting vice president of Westinghouse Electric & Manufacturing Co., died yesterday at her home, 1868 Columbia road N.W.

Mrs. Dunn was the widow of Dr. John Wesley Dunn, who died more than 50 years ago after contracting typhoid fever from one of his patients.

She is survived by a son, John D. Dunn, and a daughter, Miss Helen P. Dunn, both of Washington, and two sisters, Mrs. Edmond Barry, also of Washington, and Mrs. Eugene Mackoskey of Westminster, Md. Another daughter, Miss Dorothy Dunn, died in 1923.

Funeral services will be held at 11 a.m. tomorrow at the home, with the Rev. Dr. Oscar Blackwelder, rector of the Church of the Reformation, officiating. Burial will be in Congressional Cemetery.
