Excitement Is Fatal To Sandlot Game Fan

Excitement over the baseball game between the Mohawks and Dominican Lyceum is said to have caused the death of James W. Dunn, fifty years old, 629 M street southwest, who was a spectator of yesterday's contest.

After Dunn was taken sick at a critical stage of the game, he was taken to the Washington barracks hospital, where he died. He was an employe of the Virginia Brick Company for twenty-five years. He is survived by his widow, two sons and two daughters.
