Clarence Duvall, 76 years old, president of the real estate firm of Duvall & Co., 722 Eleventh street, who died in the Washington Sanitarium Wednesday, will be held at the home of his son, A. Malcolm Duvall, 3811 Kanawha street, tomorrow afternoon at 2 o'clock. Rev. John R. Shannon, former pastor of the Metropolitan Memorial M.E. Church, will officiate. Interment will be in Congressional Cemetery.

Mr. Duvall was widely known in this city, of which he was a native. He was educated in the public schools here and at the old Columbian College, now George Washington University.
