Cadwallader Dyer Buried in Capital

Six Members of Rifle Club Act as Pallbearers at Final Services

With six members of the National Capital Rifle Club, of which he was honorary president, acting as pallbearers, Cadwallader C. Dyer, who died Sunday at his home, 1440 Kennedy street northwest, was buried yesterday in Congressional Cemetery.

Mr. Dyer, who was 61 years old, took an active interest in the rifle organization and was a member of the National Rifle Association. He entered in competitions and rifle tournaments throughout the country and was recognized as an expert shot.

Mr. Dyer was a member of the District National Guard and last year won his distinguished rifleman qualification. He is survived by a sister, Miss Bertha O. Dyer.
