District Employee Dead

Engineer Howell B. Elliott Suddenly Passes Away

Howell B. Elliott, a valued employee of the District government, died suddenly Saturday afternoon at his home, 1373 Emerson street northeast. Deceased was one of the most popular men in the service of the District. He was kind and generous to all and a loyal friend. Several years ago he became connected with the city government, and by strict attention to duty and hard work gradually advanced until he became steam engineer at the District building.

"Captain" Elliott, as he was familiarly known, came from a prominent Maryland family. He was brought up in Harford county, but lived during the latter years of his life on his farm near Marshall Hall. He leaves a wife and four children. The funeral will take place tomorrow at 4:30 p.m. The interment will be at Congressional cemetery.
