I.H. Entwisle Rites To Be Tomorrow Retired Official of Gas Company to Be Interred in Congressional Cemetery

Funeral services for Isaac Henry Entwisle, retired official of the Washington Gas Light Co., who died at his home, 1224 North Carolina avenue northeast, Wednesday, will be conducted at Waugh M.E. Church tomorrow afternoon at 2 o'clock. Interment will be in Congressional Cemetery.

Mr. Entwisle had been in failing health for several years, but had been seriously ill only about two months.

Beginning work with the Washington Gas Light Co. when a boy, Mr. Entwisle rose through various positions to that of superintendent of meters and installation, which office he held for many years, completing a total of 48 years' service with the company. He retired last year. He was widely known as an expert on gas and various

problems pertaining to its distribution. He had represented his company at many national and interstate conferences.

Mr. Entwisle for the last 17 years had been treasurer of the Methodist Union of Washington and for 45 years had been a member of Waugh M.E. Church. He was born in this city, October 1, 1865, and had resided on Capitol Hill all his life.

Mr. Entwisle is survived by his widow, Mrs. Jessie Dony Entwisle, and three daughters, Mrs. Miriam E. Biester of Ames, Iowa; Mrs. Joseph Younger and Miss Ada R. Entwisle of this city.
