Ex-Sergt. J.R. Evans of Police Force Dies

Native of Capital, Was Retired for Disability in 1926 After 30 Years' Service

Sergt. John R. Evans, for more than 30 years a member of the police force, died last night at his home, at 3363 Brothers place southeast, at the age of 65, after a long illness.

Sergt. Evans, who was known among his many acquaintances as "Capt. Dick." was retired from the force, February 1, 1926, for physical disability. He was a native of this city.
