Funeral of Rees Evans

The funeral of Rees Evans, the well-known stone mason and contractor, who died last Saturday, took place from his late residence, 614 F street southwest, yesterday afternoon and was very largely attended. Mr. Evans was one of the star-route jurors. He leaves a wife and daughter. The pall-bearers were: Thos. Foster and Henry Steiter on the part of Columbia commandery, No. 2, K.T.; Thomas Taylor and Robert MacLeod on the part of Eureka chapter, No. 4, R.A.M., and Jerome B. Burke and Frank P. Morgan on the part of Pentalpha Lodge, No. 2, F.A.A.M. A delegation of the stone masons was also present. The funeral services at the house were conducted by the Rev. Dr. Baldwin. Mr. E.B. Hay read the Templar service. The remains were interred at Congressional cemetery with Masonic honors, the Blue lodge service being read by Mr. W.R. Bushby, W.M. of Pentalpha lodge.
