George P. Fant Commits Suicide Body Found by Sister, Mrs. Brooke M. Hoffman – Two Sons Survive

George P. Fant, 61, employe of a car cleaning service at Union Station, shot himself to death yesterday in a bedroom on an upper floor of his home, 611 Fourteenth street northeast.

The body was found lying across the bed beside a discharged shotgun by Fant's sister, Mrs. Brooke M. Hoffman, who went to the house late yesterday afternoon.

Dr. A. Magruder MacDonald, acting coroner, was informed Fant had been in ill health and subject to periods of despondency. He issued a certificate of suicide.

Fant is survived by two sons in addition to his sister.
