Adolph Feldvoss Dies

Born in Germany, But Resident Here for Fifty-Six Years

Following a brief illness, Adolph Feldvoss, a resident of the District for more than fifty-six years, died at his home, 640 South Carolina avenue southeast, Saturday.

Born in Hanover, Germany, in 1837, Mr. Feldvoss came to this country in 1865. He was one of the founders of the German-American Building Association, now the America Building Association, of this city, and acted as its treasurer for many years. He resigned his position in 1911, but has since been a member of the board of directors of the institution.

He is survived by two daughters, Mrs. Emma Slater and Mrs. Annie M. Vierbuchen, both of this city. Funeral services will be held from the residence tomorrow at 2 o'clock and interment will be in Congressional cemetery.
