Lieut. Farnbaum's Auto Struck Mrs. Chloe Fitzsimmons – The Street Accidents

Mrs. Chloe Fitzsimmons, 406 I street, who was knocked down by the automobile of Lieut. George W. Farnham, U.S.A., at 7th and K streets Saturday night, died at Casualty Hospital as a result of a fracture of her skull. Lieut. Farnham reported the accident to the police. Coroner Nevitt yesterday afternoon held an inquest at the morgue. The jury reached a verdict of accidental death, exonerating the lieutenant.
