Mrs. Blanche A. Flynn Dies; D.C. Resident 50 Years

Mrs. Blanche A. Flynn, 78, Washington resident for more than 50 years, died yesterday at her home, 325 A street N.E., after a three-week illness.

Mrs. Flynn was the widow of Joseph A. Flynn, stationmaster of Union Station for many years. He died 25 years ago.

Mrs. Flynn was born in Lunenburg County, Va., but shortly afterward her family moved to Richmon. She came to Washington about 1897 and had lived here since.
