Miss Ethel Fuss, Salvation Army Officer, Dies

Miss Ethel Fuss, 47, a Salvation Army officer here for 10 years, died of a heart attack Tuesday at Springfield, Mo., it was disclosed here yesterday.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. tomorrow at the Lee funeral home, Fourth street and Massachusetts avenue northeast, with burial in Congressional Cemetery.

A native of Washington, Miss Fuss was a daughter of the late Thomas A. and Zora Fuss. She resigned from the Salvation Army here in 1936 to go as a missionary to China, where she remained until recently. At the time of her death she was connected with the Gospel Publishing House, Springfield, Mo.

Surviving is one brother, Carlyle Fuss, of Oakland, Calif.
